In memory of Dallas - by David Yates

Hi fellow members,

I am sure we all have fond memories of Dallas. Below are just a couple of many fun times we had together.

I attended the very first meeting of the HQ Club at the Light Car Club of Australia in Queens Rd (now demolished) in approximately 1989 or 1990. I believe Dallas was also in attendance. As HQ Racing started, there were many cars being built for the flat track and the newly opened Bob Jane Thunderdome. Dallas was involved in both. The Thunderdome series was Calder, Adelaide Raceway, which Bob owned, and the new races at Surfers Paradise.

We became friendly with Dallas and decided to go to Adelaide in convoy, Dallas and his crew and myself and my two sons, Cameron and Tim. We arranged to meet each other at about 4 o'clock in the morning at McDonalds at the beginning of the West Gate Bridge. I noticed a familiar smell on Dallas' breath, very similar to Jim Beam and he assured me it was to wash the McDonald's breakfast down. Later that day we arrived at the Adelaide Raceway and before we booked into John Harding's pub at Elizabeth (John also raced HQ's at the Thunderdome) we decided to inspect the track, only very slight banking and it resembled a Go-Kart track. How wrong were we? Very deceiving and many cars had serious dents after hitting the wall. From memory, Dallas did quite well. After the races, we went back to John's pub, had many drinks and spoke many mistruths before we began our trip home.

Our next venture was to race at Surfers Paradise on the Gold Coast. From memory it was the Daiko500 along with Auscars, Nascars and American Champ cars. We finally all arrived and at the time I think there were 40 on the grid (ie: HQ's). It was the best HQ racing I have ever witnessed. The HQ pits was a dusty block of land on a corner beside the track (now hi-rise units). Practice was on Friday morning and the weather was very hot so we all decided to go for a swim afterwards. Dallas and all the crew went for a walk along the beach and he became very excited at the lovely girls in their bikinis (some topless) and at one stage I thought I might need a bucket of cold water to throw at him, however we finally managed to coax him back into the water. Back to the Racing. Before our first race, we were all gridded up in a street beside the track and whilst buckling up, I noticed there was no Dallas. Beside the line up of HQ's was a small Bar and you had to walk downstairs to get a drink. I thought the only place Dallas could be was inside that Bar and after a couple of minutes of searching, I found him with a glass of coke in his hand (not too sure of the actual ingredients). However, the races got underway and the Victorians did very well. Also racing a HQ at Surfers was Scott Wood, son of Cec and Reggie Wood and brother of Spud. There are many more memories, both on and off the track. Dallas would eat a HQ if it was possible and his friendliness, generosity and enthusiasm was of the highest standard. It was fitting that he passed away as President of his beloved HQRA. We are all the better off from having known Dallas.


